All early South Australian car registration records (starting in 1906) were lost in a fire at The Registrar of Motor Vehicles offices in Currie St., Adelaide, in August 1927. However, our Library has extensive resources enabling us to trace some or all details of the lost records. This refers to registrations in S.A. only. Let the

Sometimes we can find the first owner's name and the town where he/she resided. Not all of these parameters were recorded at all times. The Library of the Sporting Car Club will assist you in your quest. If successful, we will issue a

FRAMED CERTIFICATE at a fee of \$ 150.--

The Library will do all research and issue a personalised Certificate of Registration. This takes the form of an A4 page, printed in full colour on semi-gloss photo paper, mounted professionally under glass in a neutral frame. All we require you to provide is the registration plate number, and additionally, a high resolution photo (.jpg or .tif) of your car showing your historic plate.
