Accessibility Statement

The Sporting Car Club of South Australia Incorporated ("the Club") is committed to ensuring that our website, facilities, events and communications are accessible and inclusive for all members, competitors, volunteers and visitors.

Website Accessibility

- ensure sufficient colour contrast;
- support keyboard navigation;
- provide descriptive page headings;

- optimise the website for desktop, tablet and mobile devices;
- use meaningful alternative text for images where appropriate;
- ensure downloadable documents are readable and logically structured.

The Club is committed to continually improving website accessibility as technology evolves.

Digital Documents

Where possible, Club publications will be prepared in accessible formats.

This includes:

- newsletters;
- event information;
- membership forms;
- policy documents;
- annual reports;
- governance documents;
- event regulations.

Some historical documents or archived publications may not fully meet current accessibility standards due to their age or original format.

Assistance Available

If you experience difficulty accessing any information published by the Club, we encourage you to contact us.

Where reasonably practicable, we can provide information in an alternative format, including:

- accessible PDF;
- Microsoft Word;
- large print;
- plain text;
- verbal assistance by telephone;
- additional explanation by email.

Events and Activities

The Sporting Car Club aims to make its events as accessible as reasonably practicable.

This includes consideration of:

- accessible parking where available;
- accessible toilets where available;
- step-free access to Club facilities where possible;
- seating options;
- clear event signage;
- accessible registration processes;
- assistance from Club volunteers where appropriate.

As many Club activities occur at motorsport venues, hillclimb facilities and public roads, some locations have physical limitations that may restrict accessibility.

Where these limitations exist, the Club will endeavour to provide reasonable assistance or alternative arrangements wherever practicable.

Collingrove Hillclimb

Collingrove Hillclimb is a historic motorsport venue with unique terrain and infrastructure.

While the Club continues to invest in improving visitor facilities, some areas may have:

- uneven surfaces;
- steep gradients;
- gravel roads;
- limited accessible viewing locations;
- restricted access during competition activities.

Visitors requiring assistance are encouraged to contact the Club prior to attending an event so appropriate arrangements can be discussed.

Inclusive Participation

The Club welcomes participation from people of all backgrounds.

We are committed to providing an environment that is free from:
