SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA PERMIT NO. 526/1009/01



This Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia Hill Climb Standing Regulations,

Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Policy, the Motorsport Australia Come & Try Policy, the 2026 Collingrove Hillclimb Series Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and Bulletins that may be issued.

This Event will be held in accordance with Motorsport Australia's Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Integrity Policies, Legal Policies, Risk Management Policies, Safety 1st Framework and any other relevant Policy.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

1. EVENT STANDING

This Event is a **Club Hill Climb incorporating a Come and Try component.**

The Event will be on the 10th September 2026

The Event will be held at Collingrove Hillclimb, 71 Hillclimb Road, Mt McKenzie 5355 (8 kms from Angaston on the Eden Valley Road).

The Hillclimb is a bitumen sealed surface course, approximately 685 metres long and 3.3 metres wide. The track extension will be used for this event which is an additional 300 metres.

A SPEED LIMIT OF 10 KM/H APPLIES ON THE RETURN ROAD AND IN THE PADDOCK AREA.

4. ENTRIES

Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations.

Entries must be made using www.motorsport.org.au portal.

All entries received at the Sporting Car Club before the closing date of **4:00pm on Thursday 3rd September 2026** will pay an Entry Fee of **\$140.00 for SCC Club Members or \$175.00 for Non SCC Members or Speed-Junior (aged 14-17) Licence holders \$90.00**. Please note all Entry Fees are GST inclusive.

Come & Try entrants may enter this Event with the \$40.00 cost of a Motorsport Australia Introductory Licence included in the entry fee. An entry form will need to be completed for these entrants – visit : www.sportingcarclub.com.au

LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE EVENT ORGANISER AND A LATE PAYMENT FEE MAY APPLY.

A Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior Licence or higher is the required Motorsport Australia Licence.

The Entry Fee will not be refundable except:

- In case of the abandonment of the Event.
- Where the entry is withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Event by the fifth day prior to the Event.
- Where an entry is refused.

Entries will be limited to 100 and shall be accepted in order of receipt. Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The entry of multiple vehicles and multiple Drivers can be accepted at the sole discretion of the Organisers under the following conditions:

- An additional Entry must be raised for each entry combination.
- A separate Entry Fee is payable for each entry.

5. RUNNING ORDER

The running order will follow as closely as possible the order listed in the Official Running Sheet. Categories will be grouped for each timed run as far as possible. In the case of multiple entered vehicles, the running order will be configured and managed to ensure that each run or re-run for a particular vehicle is separated by a period of not less than five minutes, irrespective of which Driver is in the vehicle. The Organisers reserve the right to change the running order where deemed necessary.

6. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will be via Self Scrutiny Checklist which must be completed prior to the Event. Scrutineers may also conduct an audit on any of the entrant's vehicles.

- All vehicles must comply with Technical Appendix Schedule A and B of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Drivers' apparel, including helmet, is to be as per Technical Appendix Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual and must be presented to the Scrutineers for inspection upon request.
- All vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher as per Technical Appendix Schedule H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Any vehicle which, after approval, is dismantled or modified in any way which may affect the safety of the vehicle or raise questions as to its eligibility, or is involved in an accident having similar results, must be submitted for Re-Scrutiny. Any vehicle leaving the Paddock Area may also be subject to Re-Scrutiny. Any vehicle or Driver may be prohibited from the Event for safety reasons. No Competitor will be permitted to compete with exposed limbs.

7. DOCUMENTATION

Documentation must be completed prior to the Event.

Competitors and Drivers must complete all documentation and submit to motorsport@sportingcarclub.com.au prior to the Event. Documentation includes:

- Current Motorsport Australia Licence.
- Current Motorsport Australia affiliated Club Membership.
- Statement of Vehicle Compliance.

Come & Try entrants need to complete the Entry Form and Statement of Vehicle Compliance.

8. PROTESTS

Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR.

9. DRIVERS BRIEFING

Drivers Briefing notes will be sent to all competitors prior to the Event and your entry to the event constitutes acceptance of these notes. The Clerk of the Course may call a Briefing on the day. Failure to be present for the duration of the Drivers' Briefing, a penalty will be applied by the Stewards as per the Motorsport Australia Manual and may be varied by the Stewards of the Event in exceptional circumstances.

Drivers Briefing (if required) will be held outside the Scrutineering Shed. For times refer item 10, Timetable.

11. PARADES, DEMONSTRATIONS, PROMOTIONAL RIDES

This Event may include a Parade in accordance with the NCR.

Any Parade or Demonstration will be conducted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Minimum Passenger age is 12 years of age as at last birthday.

12. CANCELLATION & POSTPONEMENT

The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR or any portion thereof, at any time owing to inclement weather or any other unforeseen circumstance. Notification of **change** of the Events status will be posted on the Sporting Car Club website; www.sportingcarclub.com.au, at 6pm on the Friday evening prior to the Event.

13. RESULTS AND PRIZES

Overall results will be determined by dividing the fastest time by the record for the class. The 3 lowest percentages will be awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

No timing or prizes are available for Come & Try entrants.

14. AWARDS

Classes with 6+ entrants will be awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd place trophies.

Classes with 3 – 5 entrants will be awarded 1st & 2nd place trophies

Classes with less than 3 entrants will be awarded 1st place trophies

15. MOTOR SPORT PASSENGER RIDE

This Event may include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA), which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

16. SMOKING

Smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling or defueling operation.

INTEGRITY

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy and the Alcohol Policy, apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

17. ELIGIBLE CLASSES

The following table details the applicable classes which must be applied in their entirety and without modification.

If fewer than 3 Automobiles are entered in a class the Organiser may, at their discretion, amalgamate only the displacement classes within that category.

The Organiser may invite additional classes not listed below.
